### How many workplace incidents?



There are 9000 general workplace injuries in construction a year, affecting one in every 20 construction workers. One in every 50 workers suffers a serious injury.

#### How many workplace deaths?

Approximately nine construction workers die each year as a result of a workplace injury.





#### At what cost?


Around \$120 million is paid out annually for construction workers' compensation claims.

#### Workdays lost?

In construction, 55 days are lost for injuries needing time off work, compared to 43 days for all industries.

#### Which jobs?

Labourers are two times more likely to be injured than other construction workers.

# Which age group?

One in four injuries in construction affect workers aged between 25 and 34 years.
