How many workplace incidents?

There are around 1700 general workplace injuries in agriculture a year,



affecting one in every 25 agricultural workers. One in every 35 workers suffers a serious injury.

How many workplace deaths?

Around 15 agricultural workers die each year as a result of a workplace injury.





At what cost?

Around \$22 million is paid out annually for agriculture workers' compensation claims.

Workdays lost?

In agriculture, 50 days are lost for injuries needing time off work, compared to 43 days for all industries.



Men or women?

Men are three times more likely to suffer a work injury than women in agriculture.

Which jobs?

Machinery operators and drivers are four times more likely to be injured than other agricultural workers.

Which age group?

One in four injuries in agriculture affect workers aged between 25 and 34 years.
